

TIP TOP DOG SCHOOL RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Please make sure that your dog is under control and on-lead from your car to the Hall.
2. Please do not allow your dog to foul anywhere around the Hall or Church.
If your dog has an accident, you must make sure it is picked up and disposed of.
If you don't have a poop scoop please come to us and we will provide you with one.
If an accident occurs in the hall or on the pathway leading to the hall please come to one of the trainers or assistants and we will clean and disinfect the area.
3. Please bring treats and a bum bag, a toy, preferably a tuggy type and not a squeaky and grooming articles each week.
4. We reserve the right to refuse admission to a dog that we deem to be out of control or is displaying aggressive tendencies to humans or other canines but we will offer to assess the dog in a public place at a time to suit both parties.
5. We reserve the right to insist that a dog is muzzled in the hall if we deem it to be necessary.
6. At our discretion we will supply red bandanas for dogs in class who have a problem with other dogs being too close – usually because they are afraid. This should in no way make their handler feel bad. It is simply a way to remind other owners who are lucky enough to have sociable dogs to be considerate and give these dogs a little extra space while they are learning to be calm.
7. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times unless otherwise instructed by a trainer. This is for the safety of all dogs and handlers alike.
8. We need to see proof of vaccination at time of registration.
9. You will be required to sign a declaration stating that your dog is regularly wormed
10. No choke chains or pinch collars will be permitted. If you have been using a pinch collar or a check chain we need to be informed of this before you attend. We will need to assess your control of your dog on an ordinary collar before you attend a class.
If you require more information on this matter please contact us.
11. Please do not use a flexi (extending) lead or a chain lead for training unless we ask you to.
12. Children of all ages are welcome to the club but must be accompanied by an adult.
Young handlers (between the ages of 12 and 16) must be accompanied by an adult at all times please.
13. Ladies - for your own comfort and safety please ensure that you are wearing flat shoes or trainers.
14. Fees are payable on the day of the class please. It is possible to pay in advance for a block booking of classes at a discounted rate (valid for 3 months – fees are non-refundable).
Cash or cheques only please.
